The Best Paper Award

About the Event

The 2022 Society of South African Geographers (SSAG) conference will be hosted, from 12-14 September 2022, by the University of Pretoria. During this conference, there will be a best paper award hosted jointly by SSAG-Students and New Professional's group and International Geography Union-Young and Early Career Geographers. Students and young emerging geographers are encouraged to share their projects as a manuscript, and the best of these manuscripts will receive a certificate and monetary award, with encouragement to submit to the *South African Geographical Journal*.

Criteria for Application

Eligibility for the Young Scientist Best Paper Award is as follows:

- Scholar should be the first author (registered member of the SSAG Students and New Professional's group) and personally present an oral presentation of the paper at the SSAG conference.
- Scholar should be at a postgraduate level (*i.e.*, MSc/PhD) or within 5 years of PhD completion.
- Scholars from all the disciplines are encouraged participate with a paper based on the theme of Human Geography, Physical Geography, Remote Sensing & GIS, or other geography-related themes.
